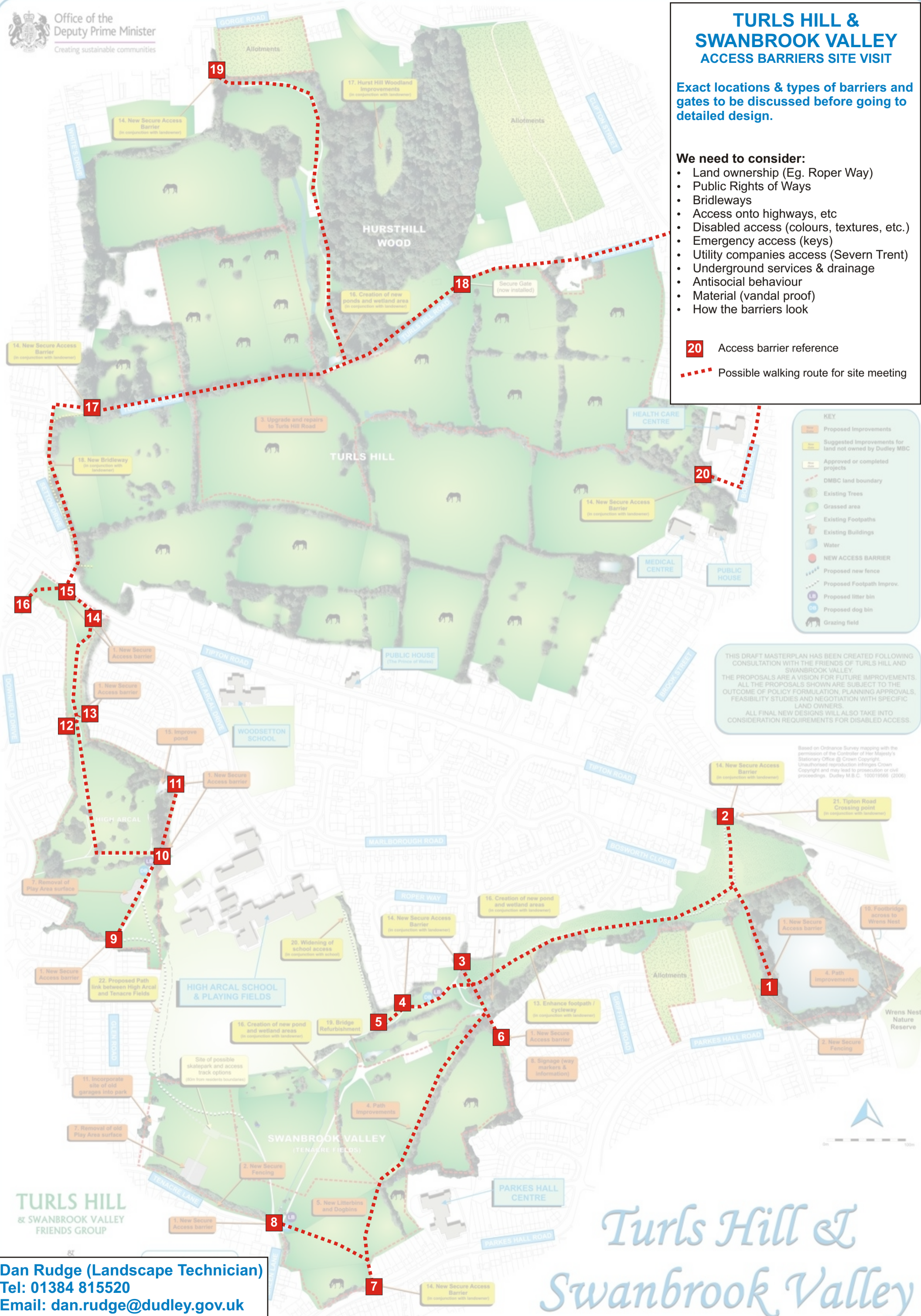
Exact locations & types of barriers and gates to be discussed before going to detailed design.

- Antisocial behaviour
- Material (vandal proof)
